Pudukkottai Kamban Association's 47th Annual Festival

Kambaramayanam will withstand 'the test of time': Justice Ramasubramanian 12 receive Kamban Award

Pudukkottai, July 27- Pudukkottai District's Kamban Association celebrated its 47th Kamban Festival for 10 consecutive days at Pudukkottai Town Hall, recently.

The 9th day of the festival had its award ceremony on 23rd of July. Justice, Supreme Court, New Delhi V. Ramasubramanian presided over the function and presented the awards. Pudukkottai Council President Tilakavathi Senthil felicitated the winners of various competitions organized by Kamban Kazhagam on the occasion. Government Advocate Senthilkumar welcomed the gathering. Justice, Supreme Court, New Delhi V. Ramasubramanian while addressing the gathering said that "I have been associated myself with Kamban Association for the past 45 years. I have also been a student of Chennai Kamban Association in 1977. In the past, Kamban festivals were held for three days, two days and then was reduced to one day and few hour programmes. But Pudukkottai Kamban Association has done a commendable job by successfully organizing programmes for 10 consecutive days. It was only after the 17th century that the judiciary has got to wear black robes. However, the great poet Kamban has already mentioned the



black robe associating it with justice in his work way before, through his characters. Poems by Shelley, Byron and William Wordsworth who lived in 200 years ago have been included in the textbooks around the world. But Kambaramayanam, one among the well versed in world literature has not received the recognition it deserves yet. 

Using AI to train teams of robots to work together

When communication lines are open, individual agents such as robots or drones can work together to collaborate and complete a task. But what if they aren't equipped with the right hardware or the signals are blocked, making communication impossible? University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign researchers started with this more difficult challenge. They developed a method to train multiple agents to work together using multi-agent reinforcement learning, a type of artificial intelligence. "It's easier when agents can talk to each other,"

said Huy Tran, an aerospace engineer at Illinois. "But we wanted to do this in a way that's decentralized, meaning that they don't talk to each other. We also focused on situations where it's not obvious what the different roles or jobs for the agents should be." Tran said this scenario is much more complex and a harder problem because it's not clear what one agent should do versus another agent. "The interesting question is how do we learn to accomplish a task together over time," Tran said.



Tran and his collaborators used machine learning to solve this problem by creating a utility function that tells the agent when it is doing something useful or good for the team. "With team goals, it's hard to know who contributed to the win," he said. "We developed a machine learning technique that al-

lows us to identify when an individual agent contributes to the global team objective. If you look at it in terms of sports, one soccer player may score, but we also want to know about actions by other teammates that led to the goal, like assists. It's hard to understand these delayed effects."

The algorithms the researchers developed can also identify when an agent or robot is doing something that doesn't contribute to the goal.
